## **Clackmannanshire Provider Network**

## "Let's Collaborate to Fill Gaps!" Survey results

The Clacks Provider Network during its meetings have identified that there are key issues and challenges which are not being fully addressed. It was agreed that the network would consider these in more detail with a view to identifying areas where its members might be able to collaborate to address these gaps.

To take this forward, in June 22 the CPN meeting held discussions which identified these gaps.

These gaps were then the subject of a short survey issued to all members of the Clacks Provider Network on 28<sup>th</sup> June 22. This survey asked individuals to identify those areas which they felt they could contribute to filling them.

Below is the results of this survey. A total of 18 organisations responded to the survey, representing a 33% response rate from member organisations.

The areas where the most organisations are interested in collaborating are:

- Improving referral routes and systems between supports
- Reaching those who are not currently engaging with support services
- Recovery from Covid particularly in mental health, isolation and poor socialisation
- Work placements and in work support for those with additional support needs.

There were however many other areas which "scored" high in popularity – see below.

Many organisations who responded identified multiple areas that they wished to collaborate in (and in relooking might want to prioritise their involvement), other organisations who did not respond to the survey may now wish to indicate an interest in collaboration.

These results are provided to members of the network, with a view to discussing them at the next CPN meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2022 at 2pm and decide how work in this area could be taken forward.
